SJASC Chair Report July 2020 Hi Everyone-

The motion as I propose it today reads as follows:

To suspend policy that ASC be held at the Stratford Senior Center and allow the conference to take place via an online platform on the same day and time until the GSR's decide on convening in-person.

Intent- Allow for upcoming business such as elections should we not be able to meet in-person at the senior center for some time.



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This would allow us to operate fully until we are able to meet again and decide if we will continue meeting at the senior center or where else should the senior center not open for sometime. It also ensures legitimate elections can be held should we be unable to meet in person by November region.
